Ref :- Research Regulations 2016 Clause 7.2 and & Clause 7.3

As per the reference above, a research scholar shall appear before the Research Advisory Committee once in six months to make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and guidance. The six month progress reports shall be submitted by the Research Advisory Committee to the University/College with a copy to the research scholar.

The Research Advisory Committee shall record the reasons for the unsatisfactory progress report of the research Scholars and suggest corrective measures. If the research scholar fails to implement these corrective measures, the Research Advisory Committee may recommend to the Institution/College with specific reasons for cancellation of the registration of the research .

The Heads of the Research Departments/Research Centres are therefore directed to strictly adhere to the above clauses of the Research Regulations and submit the progress report of the research scholars regularly to avoid delay in the processing of fellowship bills/evaluation of the thesis
