CIRCULAR

Sub:- Recognition as Research Guide - furnishing of willingness to work as a co-guide -
directions to the Research Centres - reg

Ref :- 1) Orders of the Vice Chancellor dated 01-04-2015.
2) U.O. No. 4359/2015/Admn dated 29.04.2015.

With reference to the above, all the Heads of the Research Centres are directed to adhere to the following directions strictly.

1. When a person apply for guideship with a Centre different from her/his workplace, the consent of an approved guide from the Centre opted for, to be produced along with application; to the effect that "**I am willing to Co-guide the research scholars admitted under the guidance of (name the applicant for guideship) at this Centre, including supervision of mandatory Course Work and maintenance of attendance**". In case of co-guidance, such number will not be counted along with the total approved number of 8 scholars at a time. However, in all publications emerged out of the research, the name of guide and co-guide should invariably be included on the title page. Certificate from both guide and co-guide should be included in the thesis.
2. In the case of already approved guides, whose work place is different from the approved Centre of Research should also produce such an undertaking.
3. The research scholars already got registration under a guide, whose work place is different from the Centre of Research should also infrom this office of their co-guide, for which such research scholars should appear before their Doctoral Committee for the approval of the same. This rule is applicable for those research scholars who have atleast ONE year of remaining period of valid registration.

Amendment to the rules & regulations of Ph.D Programme-2012 - Item No.1.2 of the minutes of the LXXII meeting of the Academic Council held on 15.01.2015 -implemented - modifications - approved - Orders issued.

ORDER

The following modifications are made in the order cited at first above .

Item No 1.2(2)

M.Phil degree holders shall be exempted from the course work examination *i.e.*, Regular M.Phil Degree (with equivalency) with Compulsory Course Work & Methodology in the relevant area of Ph.D research. The relevant area shall be ascertained by the Doctoral Committee.

Item No.1.2(5)

Only a minimum pass in the entrance examination is required in the case of SC/STcategory . (The admission will be subject to the vacancies available)

University Order has already been issued as per reference cited (5) stating that only a minimum pass in the entrance examination is required in the case of SC/ST category for admission to the seats reserved for them w.e.f. 2013 Admission onwards .It was further modified that "the minimum cut-off marks required for SC/ST candidates to qualify the Ph.D. entrance examination (to the seats reserved for SC/ST category) is fixed as 35% with effect from 2013 Admission onwards" vide the reference (6)cited.

Item No.1.2(6)

Allow qualified applicants including retired guides for the guide-ship disregarding the geographical jurisdiction of the University .

The following conditions are also to be adhered .

- (a) This clause is an addition to the existing regulation for granting guideship
- (b) The applicants shall apply through one of the approved research Centres of this University.
- (c) When a faculty applies for guideship with a Centre different from her/his workplace, the consent of an approved guide from the Centre opted for, to be produced along with formal application; to the effect that " I am willing to be the Co-guide of the research scholars admitted under the guidance of (name of the applicant for guideship) at this centre, including supervision of mandatory Course Work and maintenance of attendance". In the case of co-guidance, such number shall not be counted along with the total permitted number of eight Ph.D scholars at a time.

Sanction has been accorded by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor vide reference cited (4) to modify the U.O. already issued incorporating the above expansions suggested by the Director, Directorate of Research .

It was suggested that the Orders may be issued incorporating these modifications subject to the ratification by the Academic council.

This was approved by the Vice-Chancellor vide reference cited (6) and *sanction accorded for:*

(i) *to incorporate the expansions to item No.1.2(2), 1.2(5) & 1.2(6) of the amendments to the rules & regulations of the Ph.D. Programme-2012 as follows:*

Item No.1.2.(2) : *M.Phil degree holders shall be exempted from the course work examination . i.e., **Regular M.Phil Degree (with equivalency) with Compulsory Course Work & Methodology in the relevant area of the Ph.D. research. The relevant area shall be ascertained by the Doctoral Committee.***

Item No.1.2 (5): The U.O vide reference cited (5) on the minimum cut-off marks required for SC/ST candidates to qualify the Ph.D. entrance examination (to the seats reserved for SC/ST category) fixed as 35% with effect from 2013 Admission onwards is also **subject to the ratification by the Academic Council.**

Item No.1.2.(6): Allow qualified applicants including retired guides for the guide-ship disregarding the geographical jurisdiction of the University; **subject to the following conditions:**

(a) This clause is an addition to the existing regulation for granting guideship

(b) The applicants shall apply through one of the approved research Centres of this University.

(c) When a faculty member applies for guideship attached with a Centre different from her/his workplace, the consent of an approved guide from the Centre opted for to be produced along with formal application to the effect that "I am willing to Co-guide the research scholars admitted under the guidance of (name the applicant for guideship) at this Centre, including supervision of mandatory Course Work and maintenance of attendance". In the case of co-guidance, such number shall not be counted along with the total permitted number of 8 PhD scholars at a time.

ii) and to modify the University Orders issued in this regard **subject to the ratification by the Academic Council.**

The University Orders cited (1), (2) & (5) under reference are modified to this extent, vide ref (6) cited, subject to the ratification by the Academic Council,

Orders are issued accordingly.
