ORDER

As per paper read (1) above, the Principal, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi has submitted an application for recognition of the Department of Commerce as Research Centre of the University of Calicut.

Considering the request, the Vice-Chancellor, vide U.O. read (2) above, appointed Dr. Richard Scaria (Member Syndicate), Dr. Aparna Sajeev, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce & Management Studies, University of Calicut (Subject Expert) and Director, Directorate of Research as members of the Research Recognition Committee to inspect and report on the facilities available in the Department of Commerce, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi, for consideration of their application for recognition as Research Centre of the University of Calicut. The appointment of the Committee has been informed to the Principal, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi, and the members of the Research Recognition Committee vide reference (3) above.

The Committee inspected the Centre and submitted its report vide paper read (4) above, which unanimously recommended to grant recognition to the Department of Commerce, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi, as Research Centre of the University of Calicut with the following suggestions.

- (i) To procure more domain specific recent books to further help students in contemporary research methods in social sciences and management.
- (ii) To promote interdisciplinary research which benefits academic progression and community at large.

- (iii) To conduct more research orientation workshops at Postgraduate levels.
- (iv) To identify a specific area of research which is to be undertaken in the centre, and to suggest a name for the centre. It is observed that faculty of the department mostly are pursuing research in Human Resource Management and Marketing.
- (v) To immediately complete the safekeeping facility work for candidates in the research room.
- (vi) To apply for other alternative funding sources to conduct more workshops and research orientation activities.

The matter has been placed before the Syndicate for consideration. On the basis of the report of the Research Recognition Committee, as per paper read (5) above, the Syndicate has resolved to grant recognition to the Department of Commerce, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi as Research Centre of the University of Calicut.

Sanction has been accorded by the Vice-Chancellor, as per paper read (6) above, to implement the minutes of the Syndicate meeting held on 16.03.2024, vide Item No.2024.367 (Confirmed vide Item No. 2024.403 on 16.03.2024), granting recognition to the Department of Commerce, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi as the Research Centre of the University of Calicut.

Therefore, provisional recognition as the Research Centre of the University of Calicut is granted to the Department of Commerce, Sree Neelakanta Govt. Sanskrit College, Pattambi for a period of five years from 02.04.2024 to 01.04.2029. The College has to apply for renewal of Research Centre recognition of the Department of Commerce well in advance before the expiry of the present term, by remitting the fee fixed by the University of Calicut.
